

## Zion Lutheran Preschool-Medical Health Care Policy

The following Medical/Health Care Policy has been adopted for the Zion Lutheran Preschool:

Due to the relatively short length of time children attend each school session, the preschool will not administer non-prescription medication or a non-prescribed health care procedure.

The preschool will not administer prescription medications or a prescribed health care procedure to a child.

For any medication prescribed or over the counter medication administered to a child prior to school, which may have an unusual affect on the child's health or behavior in school, we ask that you inform director or classroom teacher prior to class.

The preschool will administer and follow trained first aid procedures and emergency care procedures.

The preschool will provide reasonable accommodations for the administration of medication or health care procedures to a child with special needs, if failure to do so will jeopardize the health of the child or prevent the child from attending preschool.

If your child has a special health care need or procedure that would need to be administered during school hours, please contact and inform the Director. At that time, you will be given the proper parental and physician forms for permission and procedure.

The parent signature on the following page is an indication of the parental acceptance of the guidelines and procedures listed in the above policy and will follow them to safeguard the health and safety of their child.
