## A Typical Day at Zion

Zion Lutheran Preschool offers a nurturing, Christian environment for the surrounding area's children and families.

We encourage growth, spiritually and emotionally, socially and intellectually, through an environment with age and developmentally appropriate curriculums.

We are a state licensed school with state certified staff and teachers.

Our school runs from September to June. We offer many programs for various age groups.

Our programs offer music and movement, hands on science and social studies. We have a proven effective pre-writing and pre-reading curriculum which complements any public school curriculum.

We are unique in that we offer a three-hour program for our half day children. Most preschools offer 2.5 hours.

Our full day programs offer enrichment activities and a second outdoor organized gross motor session.

The day begins with Table Time play emphasizing fine motor skills, social interaction and creative play. We have combined the very best aspects of the state approved preschool curriculums to give your child the most quality education available.

During Circle Time the children learn about the calendar, weather and important age appropriate curriculum themes. They are introduced to various academic themes including social studies, language arts, science and math. They participate in story time, sing songs, and play various movement games and take part in hands on learning activities.

The children have an opportunity for active play outside (weather permitting), or in the fellowship hall where they practice large motor activities. Free play indoors, offers a variety of choices and classrooms are inviting and set up in quality learning centers.

Story Time gives the children and opportunity to develop a love of reading.

Preparation to go home involves reviewing the day's events and saying goodbye to our friends.
